The Liberty Project



The Liberty Project © is a small Christian faith based, non-profit organisation located in Nacala, Northern Mozambique.

Our heart is to see young women liberated from abuse, exploitation and cultural oppression. We work to empower each woman through discipleship, education, skills training and employment in social enterprise.

It's estimated that around 98% of Mozambican females have been sexually abused; whether it be from cultural ceremony, sexual exploitation or through the 'norms' of womanhood that culture perpetrates.

Laura Monahan is a missionary based in Nacala. Her role is founder and director of The Liberty Project - Based on Isaiah 61.

Dear Friends

These last two months have been an exciting time of new steps forward for us. We have welcomed 10 students into our first ever Hospitality Training Programme in Nacala.

Ten women, three who graduated from our Freedom Programme in Quarter 2 and seven new, will be with us until April 2025. They will learn all about bread, baking cakes, cooking, serving and espresso based coffee making. So far, we are deep into our bread baking part of the course and have completed Turkish Pide, Ciabatta, Focaccia, French Baguettes, Tortillas, Italian white loaf, seeded loaf, scones and much more!

Artisanal Development



We've been blessed with some skilled helpers this quarter to help us develop new products. All these designs will be taught by Ima (left) to our Artisanal Development students.

They will then be contracted by our Liberty Design Studio when we receive orders, providing for them a fair and dignified income as well as a great sense of achievement.



Equipping & Empowering

One of the major contributing factors towards exploitation and abuse of women is the lack of independence. Women are taught to fully rely on men for their provision and their survival. This keeps women trapped in dangerous situations. We believe the teaching of God's design and true identity in Jesus Christ; equipping women with new skills and employment opportunities is vital in breaking the chains of exploitation and oppression. We aim to open The Liberty Market and Kitchen in April 2025 - this will provide employment to our graduates, along with an environment of growth, encouragement and Godly input in their lives. Please be praying for this need and the quality of work.

This month we visited Loloma House on Nadi. Loloma House is a retirement village however it also takes in others in need.

In the picture below of the group of people, the ladies in the front row of the photo (standing and sitting to the right of me), we have supported and served with food. The four-year-old girl and the baby were left by their parents and the 16-year-old girl had her left forearm chopped off by her step-father in a domestic dispute, the other five ladies are without homes. We visited them, along with some of our church members and we blessed them with a cooked lunch (see photos below) and gave them towels and toilet paper.

We told them that this support was from New Day church in New Zealand and they were all very grateful. The management of the Loloma House wanted me to pass on their appreciation too.
